Jakarta EE – Future Vision Initiative [was: Beyond Jakarta EE 11]

Neil Patterson provided an update on this initiative on March 26 (see below).

The [working document](#) has been updated/replaced with a new one that better organizes the material, defines the steps and status of each, and provides some guidance on the responsibilities for the various ideas that were generated. From the [document](#), the following outlines these steps and progress.

1. [Complete] Brainstorm about directions we should take Jakarta EE after release 11 is out. This will involve working sessions with the Steering Committee, Spec Committee, Marketing Committee and member organizations.
2. [Complete] Generate a working document that will influence the next generation of specs, messaging, content, and more.
3. [In Progress] Integrate top ideas into the technical survey to gather feedback.
4. [In Progress] Deliver specification and working group recommendations to relevant committees.
5. [In Progress] Form an [interest group](#) (Name TBD) to prioritize and explore the topics in greater detail, especially those beyond the typical Jakarta EE scope. Initial participation interest: Microsoft, Payara, IBM, Oracle. Tomitribe

Objectives

- Tanja is preparing a Q1 report and plans to have it for review in the next meeting (in Steering Committee folder)
- Update on growing contributors and reward committers (Will/Oracle)
 - As stated in prior minutes, I added two new objectives:
 - “Publish # of contributors, committers by WG member”
 - Members represent large % of contributors, committers
 - Publishing this data may encourage more contributors
 - The Eclipse Foundation is working on this.
 - Analyze issues opened by non-contributors. Assess targeting this group.

- Potential pool of future contributors
 - I will follow up with Tanja following completion of the above,
 - No updates were provided on April 23.
- Provide Integrations as Required with MicroProfile (Reza/Microsoft)
 - Reza has made several updates (thank you)
 - We did not have a chance to review these in the last meeting
 - Note: This topic was not reviewed April 23 - I will include on the agenda for May 7.

Jakarta EE Technical Survey

- Target for 2nd Half 2024
- Plan to collaborate with MicroProfile for technical questions. Will limit SDK questions to common Java topics and not focus on any SDK vendor/project
- First draft questions are in review now, through April 25

- Lots of work behind the scenes, organization. Open Community Java and umbrella context is still in the process of being developed. Recommend you hold the date and sponsorship requests are welcomed.

Cloud Native Java Certification

- From Reza
 - Reza observes that developers often want to have “certifications” to include on their credentials
 - Suggests we initiate a certification to address this need
 - Believes a “Cloud Native Java” certification that spans Jakarta EE and MicroProfile would be more desirable than “Jakarta EE” or “MicroProfile by itself
 - Could help build developer/community mindshare
- From Emily
 - Agrees, worthwhile exercise, IBM had proposed something similar
- From Will
 - A similar concept proposal had been brought forward in prior years (2021-2022)
 - A scaled back “badging proposal” was presented at this Committee, but this committee chose not to pursue this proposal

- From Tanja
 - The following items have been discussed in the past - the 2024 marketing plan currently lists the following as out of scope
 - Explore program for expanding use of Jakarta EE in educational institutions -out of the scope
 - Jakarta EE Badging/Certification-out of the scope
 - Explore the creation of a Jakarta EE Champions Program-out of the scope
