  - Component specs "Done": 29 (all component specs done)
  - The current Platform specifications are not in ballot.
- Note from last time
  - The current target announcement date (per last Steering Committee meeting) is Tuesday, July 12. Our goal is that all three platform specifications be approved at the time of announcement. To make the July 12 announcement date, all platform specs must be in ballot NLT June 28.
    - What is the current assessment of making the June 28 target date with ballots that are likely to pass?
    - Only a small number of tests are not passing we are confident that we will resolve these in the next week.
  - We agreed that if all three specs are not in ballot by June 28, we will push out the announcement by one week.
- Emily updated the group based on the Platform team meeting. All of the Platform specs have open issues. Three items need to be fixed. It is possible these issues will be addressed this week.
  - The group consensus was that we should move the announcement date out to July 26
  - Emily will send out an update on this towards the end of this week


