Patent License Option Choice for Jakarta Config Project

Dear Jakarta EE Steering Committee,

On Wednesday, May 26th the Specification Committee ballot for the creation of the Jakarta Config specification project wraps up. I anticipate the ballot passing based on the current votes that have been cast.

Prior to creation of a new Specification Project, as per the [Eclipse Foundation IP Policy](#) [See VI. SPECIFICATION PROCESS], it has to be decided if the project will be under either the Compatible License Option or the Implementation License Option. See Mike's [blog](#) for additional information.

The purpose of this email is in anticipation of the successful outcome of the Creation Review for the Jakarta Config project, the Steering Committee needs to establish a position regarding the patent option for this project.

Here are resolutions for the options, my recommendation is for the Steering Committee to establish a consensus on which one to take to ballot and then conduct your ballot.

Implementation Patent License
